Dear Parents,

Although it seems difficult to believe, it is time to start scheduling appointments for senior portraits. Bishop McDevitt is contracted with the Camera Box for all formal senior portraits. Students must have their formal portrait taken at the Camera Box for it to appear in the yearbook.

You should have received information in the mail from the Camera Box regarding scheduling an appointment along with pricing information. If you have not received this information please let me know, and I will make sure you receive it in the mail. Appointments should be made as soon as possible as appointment times fill quickly. **Portraits must be taken by the second week in September for them to appear in the yearbook.**

Students have already been informed of the proper dress code for senior portraits. Students who choose to have informal or casual pictures taken may wear whatever they would like for those photos, however for the formal portrait which will appear in the yearbook, students must be in school dress code. **ANY STUDENT NOT IN DRESS CODE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO HAVE THEIR PORTRAIT APPEAR IN THE YEARBOOK**

GIRLS: No spaghetti straps
No strapless tops
No piercings – except ears which are limited to two piercings per ear
No visible cleavage
Hair neatly combed, no hairspray or coloring that is bizarre or attention getting
We recommend girls use the black drape provided by the Camera Box for their yearbook photo. It offsets nicely with the design of the senior section.

BOYS: Must wear **sport coat, dress shirt and tie**, preferably dark in color
Must be clean shaven, with the exception of a small mustache
Hair must NOT touch the top of their collar, may not cover ANY part of their ears, and may NOT be held in place by hair bands, barrettes, rubber bands or other tie-up devices
Braids are allowed; however length must not be over the ears or shirt collar
NO PIERCINGS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED

We are asking parents to please review the dress code and understand that if a dress code violation occurs, you child's portrait will not appear in their senior yearbook. **ALL FINAL DECISIONS WILL BE MADE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE YEARBOOK MODERATOR AND THE PRINCIPAL.**
