Standard scanning includes pressurized air removal of dust and debris plus automatic software image cleanup. Note some dust spots may remain in scans of this type from extremely dirty film. Images are scanned for full frame, rotated to proper orientation, and adjusted for basic color, density and contrast. Negatives and slides are scanned at 2400 ppi.

Pro Scan (all sizes).....**\$15 each** Pro Scans include pressurized air removal of dust plus hand cleanup of remaining dust spots in Photoshop. Images are extensively corrected for color, density and contrast. Negatives and slides are scanned at 4800 ppi.

Restoration Fees

In order to prevent further damage, no restoration work is done to original photographs. Instead, your photo is scanned and the image is repaired and corrected digitally by a skilled computer expert. The different levels of restoration work are listed below.

Restoration Fee Does Not Include the Cost of Prints

Oversize Copy Fee\$15.00

This fee is required if your original is larger than 8x10, or if it is in a frame. Unframed prints smaller than 8x10 do not require this fee.

Basic Restoration \$55.00

The basic restoration is perfect for photographs which are moderately damaged by tears and creases. Facial features should be intact and in good condition. Prints can also be enhanced for color and density.

Common Problems

Faded Originals

If your original print is badly faded, we may be able to enhance the details, but we will not be able to restore the original features that have disappeared over the years. Most photographs can be improved with the enhancing process.

Size Problems

Even with the latest advances in technology, photographs should not be "over enlarged." In most cases, a restored picture should not be duplicated more than twice the size of the original. Therefore, if your original is 4x5", it should not be enlarged to more than 8x10" in size.

Uncommon Print Sizes

Old photographs rarely fall into the standard size categories that we use today. Therefore we may not be able to reproduce your restored photograph as a standard size without cropping the image.

Scanning Old Film

In most cases, Camera Box can scan from old slides or negatives. We can reproduce prints from your images if you like, or deliver the scans to you on a CD-ROM or USB Thumbdrive.
